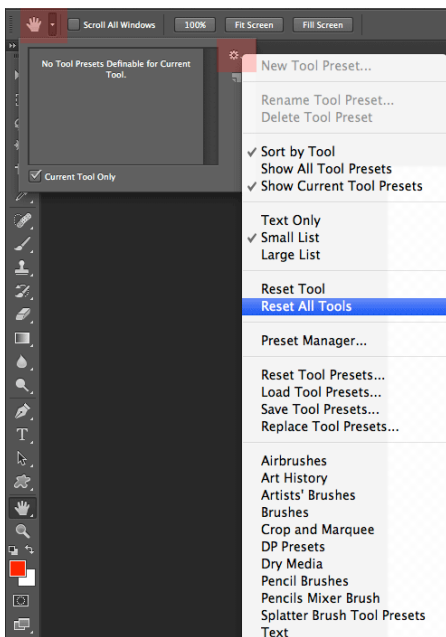


RGB Model

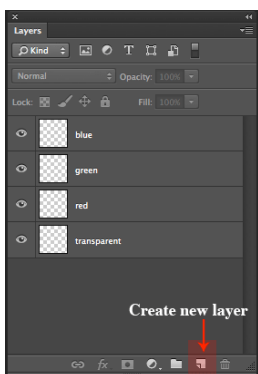
1. Open Adobe Photoshop CS6, file>new, call it rgbModel, 500x500 pixels, rgb color mode, 72ppi, transparent background

Reset Photoshop to defaults

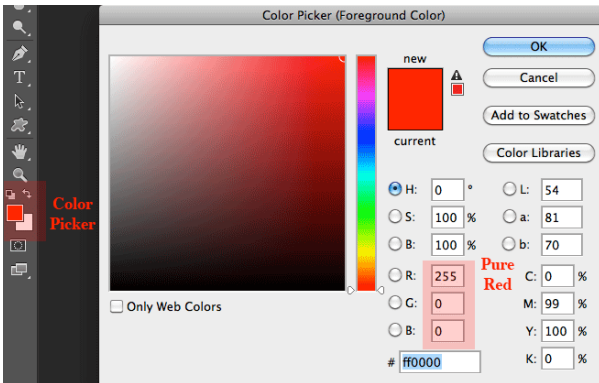
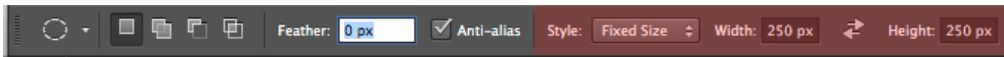
2. Essentials, Right click (Option click) Essential>Reset Essentials
3. Click sub-menu triangle, next to tool showing in the tool bar
4. Click sub-menu triangle>Reset All Tools>OK



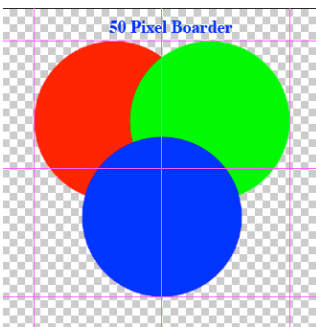
5. Click sub-menu triangle, next to tool showing in the tool bar to close sub-menu
6. Rename layer 1 to transparent, by double clicking the present label name
7. Make 3 new layers, naming them red, green, and blue



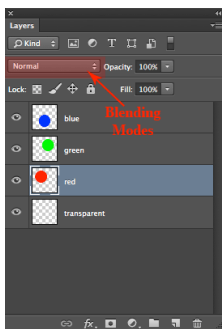
8. Make sure the red layer is selected
9. Make a 250 diameter circle on the red layer, in the color picker, in the rgb selections, pick pure red and fill the red layers circle with it. Do the same to the green and blue layers



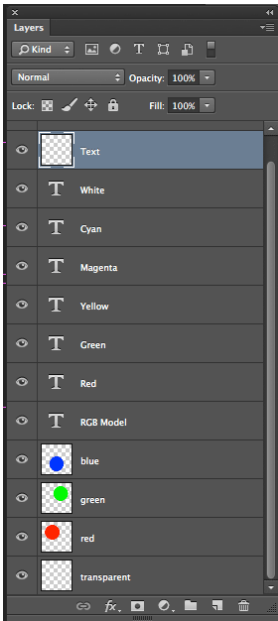
10. Select>Deselect (Cmd + D) to make the Marching Ants disappear
11. With the Move Tool, arrange the circles so they form a 3-ring look
12. Set Guides to ensure centered placement of objects



13. Turn the red, green, and blue layers “Blending Mode” to “Screen”



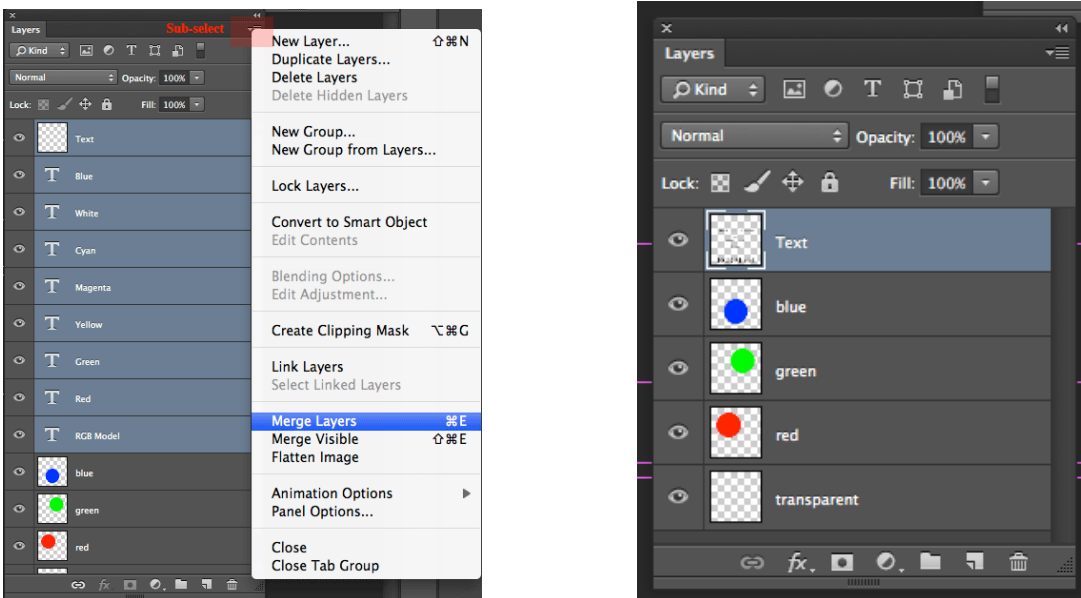
14. At the bottom of your project , put the title “RGB Model”, Times, Bold, 72 pts, Black
15. Label each primary (48 pt Black), secondary color (24 pt Black), and the white area (14 pt Black). Notice, as you make each text word, you will get a new layer, and there will be a "T" next to the layer name. Let these layers build one on top of another
16. Make a new layer at the very top, label it “text”



After you have placed all the words, you will merge all the text onto the “text” layer, so you will end up with 5 layers. Make sure they are arranged neatly.

17. Select your “text” labeled layer (the layer that doesn't have a “T”) go to each of the other layers that have editable text in them and click on them while hold the Shift key down.

18. Go to the sub-menu in the layers palette and choose “Merge Layers”. Save the file as LastNameRGB.tif, with LZW compression – **With all 5 layers**



19. From Layer sub-menu>Flatten Image and save as LastNameRGB.jpg Medium Quality.
